## QUIG QUAICH 2023

The subjects this year are:-

1. **PORTRAITURE**
2. **ABANDONED**
3. **SEASCAPES**
4. **SPORT**
5. **CONTOURS**
6. **WILDLIFE**

Normal competition rules apply with the addition of the following:-

- Images entered must have been taken after the date of the 2023 AGM, i.e. **on or after the 18<sup>th</sup> April 2023** and anytime up to the **FIRST CLUB MEETING** of the 2023-2024 season in September.
- Images must not have been entered in any other competition prior to the hand-in date. This applies to all formats of images.
- Entries can be a combination of either B&W prints, Colour prints or digital images for projection.
- Enter two images (maximum) from any three of the above subjects
- A full entry is **six images per entrant** with the highest aggregate score being the winner.
- The entry will be judged at a club meeting to be arranged in September/October 2023.
- Note - images entered in the Quaich competition can also be entered into any club competition which is judged subsequent to the Quaich judging night, and so may be entered in the Rose Urie or any subsequent Open competition subject to normal club rules.

For Digital Projected images, the native resolution of the new club projector is 1600 pixels x 1200 pixels so landscape format images can be a maximum of 1600 pixels on the horizontal plane while portrait format should be 1200 pixels high on the vertical plane.

The images must be in j-peg format. Note that portrait format images cannot be 1600 pixels' high.
